A student in your child's classroom has been diagnosed with CRYPTOSPORIDIOSIS, a disease that is contagious. Please read the information below and watch your child for any signs or symptoms of this illness. Thank you for helping to decrease the spread of illness in our classrooms.

Please notify your center if your child is home ill.

Cryptosporidiosis

Signs and Symptoms of Illness

• Watery diarrhea & stomach ache – can involve vomiting, general ill feeling and fever.

How Disease is Spread

 Through contact with feces (bowel movement) through humans, animals, contaminated food, water.

When Illness Occurs After Being Exposed

Anywhere between 1-12 days.

How Long Can Disease Be Spread

For several weeks.

Prevention

 Good hand-washing techniques after changing diapers, toileting, handling animals and before fixing food. <u>Careful</u> disinfecting of diaper changing area and bathroom is necessary.

Exclusion From School

Until child or staff has no diarrhea.

REMEMBER: Please don't bring your children to school with a fever greater than 100.4° F.
