LOOK FOR THESE **SIGNS**

Before sending you kids to school

TEMPERATURE

An oral temperature over 100 degrees taken under the arm.





A painful red throat, even if no fever is present or a deep hacking cough.

CONGESTION

Severe congestion or difficulty breathing.



ADDITIONAL SIGNS

- Vomiting more than once in the past 24 hours
- Diarrhea that is bloody may need medical attention.
- -Complaints of a stiff neck or severe headache.
- Thick green drainage from the nose along with along with sinus pressure, fever or tiredness.
- An unusual yellow coloring of the skin.
- Cuts or open wounds on the skin that are pus-filled.
- believed to be contagious.
